Family Camp Fee Structure

Family Camp fees are determined by your requested accommodations and the number of people in your family group. Conference Center rooms have private bathrooms and air conditioning. Cabins have shared bathrooms, fans, and you supply linens for twin bed.

The first two people in your party to register, regardless of age, pay the set amount listed above by your session name. Each additional camper is \$85 (conference center) or \$75 (cabin).

Youth Camp Tiered Pricing

Procter will **always** work with families and churches to provide Campership funds to make camp available to all regardless of financial ability to pay. This fee structure relies on the honor system, we trust you to make the best choice for your family. The rate your family pays is confidential; all campers receive the same camp experience regardless of which tier you choose.

Tier 1- Subsidized Cost: This is the historically subsidized rate, and does not reflect the true cost of Procter's summer operations. The Subsidized rate is available thanks to mission share funds, Friends of Procter, and other Diocesan support. This is very nearly the rate you have always paid.

Tier 2- Direct Cost: Direct costs covers our direct program costs, camp staff stipends, food and administrative costs.

Tier 3- True Cost: This rate more closely accounts for the TRUE costs of camp after Diocesan support for the program. Families who can afford to pay Tier 3 are encouraged to do so. True costs include all direct costs plus deferred maintenance etc. You help Procter make needed upgrades and continue to grow in the future.

Campership- For families unable to pay the Subsidized Rate. Procter and the Diocese of Southern Ohio are committed to making camp accessible for all campers, adults and children, regardless of ability to pay. Campership is supported by private donations and Bishop Breidenthal's plate collection at parish visits. Your donations help send a child or family to camp
